1. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first served basis
2. Places in the Explorer Scout Unit are available to registered Explorer Scouts/Young Leaders who will be aged between 13.5 and under 18 years old as at 1<sup>st</sup> August 2009.
3. Places on IST (or as Assistant Leaders/Contingent Support Team if required) are available to registered and CRB'd adult leaders, Network or Fellowship members aged 18 and above as at 1<sup>st</sup> August 2009.
4. Further information will be sent out by email where possible.
5. Each person will need to ensure they have a British passport with a minimum of 6 months validity at the date of the trip. Please could you enclose a photocopy of your passport with this form.
6. We also recommend that each person attending the trip over the age of 16 applies for a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) which replaced the old E111 Form. This provides some medical insurance cover whilst travelling in Europe.
