### INSTRUCTIONS

**Option 1** Place the animal cards randomly around the playing area, on trees, lamp posts, doors etc. You can play this around your HQ's grounds or in your local area, in small adult-supervised groups. Encourage the Beavers to talk about the animals on the card or do an impression. I.e for a Flamingo they could stand on one leg

The first letter of the animal is the letter. I.e a Dog would be D

Beavers look around the area you tell them and try to find the cards. When found, they write down the animal's letter. When they have found them all, can they decode the secret message?

Messages are 'Beavers Is Fun' Skills For Life'

**Option 2** Place the cards in 2 piles on the floor in your meeting place. With the beavers in 2 teams

1. The beavers run up in a relay and collect the top card.

2. The winning team is the team that has spelt out their message first.
