Employees

It is useful to note that some companies, such as Mobil, most of the Banks, and Fords have money available to help organisations that their employees belong to. Fords in particular, will pay for employee's training. B.P., Shell and Rank Xerox have a system of matched funding. Midland Bank has two schemes available. Tesco gives 20% top-up to money raised.
